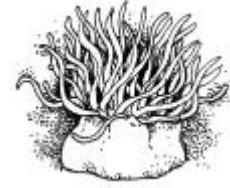

**SEASHORE ZONES**

Every beach is different from another, but they all have distinct areas. For instance, the zone above the high water mark is different from the areas below it which get covered twice a day in salt water.

**Imagine there is a line dividing the beach into four zones. Make a list or draw the plants and animals you find in each of the zones. Alternatively your teacher may want to mark out a line down the beach (a transect) and place hoops at intervals down the line for you to investigate.**

**Zone 1: Above the Strandline**

**Zone 2: Strandline and top of beach**

**Zone 3: Middle of the beach**

**Zone 4: Bottom of the beach**
